 - 2b.If cancellation occurs between 60 days and 30 days prior to the start of the event, the cancellation fee is 50% of the registration fee.
 - 2c. If cancellation occurs more than 60 days prior to the start of the event, the cancellation fee is 3,000 yen for administrative costs.
